2011 Advanced Research Program Grant Competition*

Targeted Research Areas:

Molecular Biology, Cellular Biology and Genetics (excluding cancer related research) and Materials Science/Nanoscience.

Eligibility:

The PI must be an “Early Career Investigator” defined as a non-tenured, tenure track faculty member or a research professional from an eligible institution who has been employed at the institution for not less than two years and not more than five years, as of the pre-proposal submission date.

An investigator may be named on a maximum of one individual pre-proposal. Only single investigator, single institution proposals may be submitted.

Funds Available:

Up to \$80,000 for the two-year project.

Submission:

Notice of Intent (attached) due to Office of Research (research@tamhsc.edu) by 5:00 PM, August 25, 2011. If Notice of Intent is not provided you will NOT be allowed to submit.

Pre-proposals are required for all research areas. They must be completed on-line and submitted electronically through the Office of Research and Graduate Studies (Research@tamhsc.edu) by **5:00 PM, September 15, 2011.**

All participating investigators must register or update existing accounts with the ARPATP On-line System before September 15, 2011.
